

## Human Trafficking Awareness

As we distribute dresses to girls in need we want to warn them and their parents / guardians of the traps of human trafficking and like to include this "awareness" during our time of dressing girls. Please take a printable copy with you when you are distributing dresses and look for and/or ask the international or national partner to give you a few minutes to share this information or ask them to share it.

Human Trafficking is the second largest criminal enterprise in the world, after drug smuggling and arms dealing.

A child is trafficked every 30 seconds.

According to estimates, approximately 80% of trafficking involves sexual exploitation, and 19% involves labor exploitation.

The average age of a young woman being trafficked is 12-14 years old.

1.2 million children are brought into slave trade each year.

If we educate them and their parents/guardians they are less likely to be deceived.

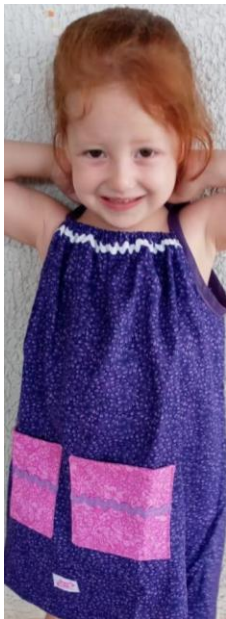

Our local DAG team meets in Tupper Lake periodically to make dresses for God’s little girls. So far, we’ve made over 5,200 dresses that we’ve sent to Haiti, Nepal, South America, Uganda, India, Romania, Brazil, and Cambodia. We also distribute dresses through Operation Christmas Child shoe boxes.
